### Step 1) File your taxes

- Most of the information on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) comes from your tax return. If you haven't filled out your taxes yet, we may be able help you get them done for free, depending on your income.

### Step 2) File your FAFSA

- We'll walk you through the process. You can start applying for this money as early as January 1 and it runs out very quickly—usually before the end of March—so don't wait!

### Step 3) Call with any questions

Financial Resource Volunteers at these 4 tax sites will help you complete the FAFSA (financial aid application)! Bring your most recent tax return with you to your appointment. Students who are considered "dependent" on the FAFSA application will need to bring their parents and their parents' tax returns to the appointment as well.

Applications may be filed all year, but it is best to submit the FAFSA by **March 1st** to ensure consideration for Maryland state grants and loans.
