

All you need to know to come to Money Power Day!

Q: How much does the event cost?

A: Money Power Day is **free** and open to anyone in the Baltimore metro area. All of the services are free, but some require certain income eligibility.

Q: Do I need to register for Money Power Day?

A: You can preregister for events through the website. Click on "Attendees, preregister NOW!" Or, you can come to the event on Saturday March 21st and sign-up that day.

Q: Can I bring my children?

A: YES! We love kids at Money Power Day. Of course you will have to watch your children, but there are all kinds of financially focused and very fun activities for kids:

- Workshops for children.
- Port Discovery's *Money Game Road Show*
- And other activities for youth up to 17 years old.

Q: How do I sign up for tax preparation?

A: All services are first come, first serve, but we encourage you to preregister for a tax appointment by calling 443-451-4076 so that we can schedule you for a time slot.

Q: How do I sign up for credit counseling sessions?

A: All services are first come, first serve and you can make a day-of appointment on the third floor where the credit counselors are located.

Q: What should I bring to the event?

A: If you are going to get your taxes prepared, please make sure to bring the following information:

- A social security card for each family member on the return
- W-2 forms for **all** jobs worked in 2008
- Childcare provider name, address, and tax ID number
- All banking account information to direct deposit your refund
- Any document or information that you have received from the IRS
- All 1099 forms for other income, if any
- Any other tax related documents you have received
- *Every adult on your return must come to sign the return*

Also, if you would like to use the on-site shredding services, please bring your sensitive documents with you the day of the event.
